

RESOLUTION NO. 4596-25

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF OVIEDO, FLORIDA, APPROVING A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR CONTINUED RIGHT-OF-WAY MAINTENANCE OF STATE ROADS 434 AND 426 WITHIN THE CITY'S CORPORATE LIMITS INCLUDING REIMBURSEMENT COSTS TO THE CITY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$94,165 ANNUALLY; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE SAID MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT; AND PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTING ADMINISTRATIVE ACTIONS, SCRIVENER'S ERRORS, CONFLICTS, SEVERABILITY, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on January 16, 2007, City Council authorized the City Manager to enter into an agreement with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) for right-of-way maintenance of State Roads 434 and 426 within the City's corporate limits; and

WHEREAS, since execution of the agreement, the City has satisfactorily maintained these roadways in accordance with said agreement; and

WHEREAS, FDOT has reimbursed the City of Oviedo quarterly, in accordance with the agreement; and

WHEREAS, the existing Highway Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement terminated on April 12, 2025; and

WHEREAS, a new agreement is necessary in order for the right-of-way maintenance on State Roads 434 and 426 within the City's corporate limits to continue without interruption.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OVIEDO, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Approval of the Memorandum of Agreement. The City Council approves the Memorandum of Agreement, Contract No. ASR53 with the Florida Department of Transportation for right-of-way maintenance of State Roads 434 and 426 within the City's corporate limits provided in Exhibit 1.

SECTION 2. Authorizing the Mayor to Execute the Memorandum of Agreement. The City Council authorizes the Mayor to execute the Memorandum of Agreement provided in Exhibit 1.

SECTION 3. Authorizing Renewal of the Agreement. The City Council authorizes the City Manager to renew the Memorandum of Agreement per Section 2 of the Memorandum of Agreement Term.

SECTION 4. Implementing Administrative Actions. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to take such actions as may be deemed necessary and appropriate in order to implement the provisions of this Resolution. The City Manager may, as deemed appropriate, necessary and convenient, delegate the powers of implementation as herein set forth to such City employees as deemed effectual and prudent.

SECTION 5. Scrivener's Errors. Typographical errors and other matters of a similar nature that do not affect the intent of this Resolution, as determined by the City Clerk and City Attorney, may be corrected.

SECTION 6. Conflicts. All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict with any of the provisions of this Resolution are hereby repealed.

SECTION 7. Severability. If any Section or portion of a Section of this Resolution proves to be invalid, unlawful, or unconstitutional, it shall not be held to invalidate or impair the validity, force, or effect of any other Section or part of this Resolution.

SECTION 8. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
