

RESOLUTION NO. 4611-25

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF OVIEDO, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE SUBMITTAL OF A GRANT APPLICATION THROUGH THE T-MOBILE HOMETOWN GRANTS PROGRAM FOR A HOMETOWN GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$50,000 FOR THE FRANKLIN STREET TREES IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, WITH ZERO REQUIRED MATCHING FUNDS FROM THE CITY; AND PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTING ADMINISTRATIVE ACTIONS, SCRIVENER'S ERRORS, CONFLICTS, SEVERABILITY, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City has an opportunity to apply for a \$50,000 Hometown Grant through the T-Mobile Hometown Grants program for the Franklin Street Trees Improvement Project; and

WHEREAS, the City's required local match will be zero dollars (\$0); and

WHEREAS, eligible projects are from small towns with a population of less than 50,000, and should be shovel-ready, physical builds or improvements that implement the requirements in the Community Planning Act; and

WHEREAS, applicants are encouraged to seek funding for physical builds or improvements that can be completed within twelve (12) months of funding receipt; and

WHEREAS, the City plans to use the grant funds to implement the Franklin Street Trees Improvement Project installing twenty-two (22) Sabal Palm trees in the Franklin Street tree wells and to improve the existing twenty-two (22) tree wells.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OVIEDO, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Approval of Grant Application Submittal. City Council approves the submittal of a grant application for a Hometown Grant in the amount of \$50,000 with no required City Match through the T-Mobile Hometown Grants program for the Franklin Street Trees Improvement Project.

SECTION 2. Implementing Administrative Actions. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to take such actions as may be deemed necessary and appropriate in order to implement the provisions of this Resolution. The City Manager may, as deemed appropriate, necessary and convenient, delegate the powers of implementation as herein set forth to such City employees as deemed effectual and prudent.

SECTION 3. Scrivener's Errors. Typographical errors and other matters of a similar nature that do not affect the intent of this Resolution, as determined by the City Clerk and City Attorney, may be corrected.

SECTION 4. Conflicts. All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict with any of the provisions of this Resolution are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. Severability. If any Section or portion of a Section of this Resolution proves to be invalid, unlawful, or unconstitutional, it shall not be held to invalidate or impair the validity, force, or effect of any other Section or part of this Resolution.

SECTION 6. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
