The City Council of the City of Oviedo, Florida, met in a Work Session on Monday, April 28, 2025, Oviedo City Hall, 400 Alexandria Boulevard

PUBLIC COMMENT

1. Citizen Comment

Deputy Mayor Teuchert opened public comment. Hearing no one wishing to speak, public comment was closed.

ORDER OF BUSINESS

2. FY 2025-26 Budget – April update on Capital and Personnel Requests

Finance Director Jerry Boop provided a presentation.

Council consensus was to use the unassigned fund balance to pay off existing general fund debt, construction of the Police Station Annex and CIP, Capital Outlay and equipment.

3. Oviedo Arts and Entertainment District

Assistant City Manager Patrick Kelly provided a presentation.

Council discussed and reached consensus of the majority on several items: moving the north boundary south towards the parking lot; approving the proposed consumption timing; seeking a recommendation from the Public Arts Board for the cup logo and color; establishing requirements for participating businesses; and adding a limitation that the parking lot is prohibited for use unless it is designated as an event space.

4. North Lockwood Boulevard/County Road 426 Roadway Improvements related to the new proposed Traffic Signal.

Public Works Director Bobby Wyatt and Assistant City Engineer Paul Yeargain provided a presentation.

Council provided direction on adding to the agreement that Seminole County contribute the difference towards the roadway construction as the construction cost is less than what the County had allocated.

5. Discussion on the Definition of Family

Deputy Mayor Teuchert requested and received consensus to move the item to the May 5th or May 19th regular sessions.

6. Independence Day Celebration Update

Recreation and Parks Director Paul Belden provided an Independence Day Celebration Update.

Council discussed a future work session item for the Water Conservation Grant discussion.
