COUNCIL SPECIAL SESSION MINUTES
WEDNESDAY, MAY 24, 2023**

The City Council of the City of Oviedo, Florida, met in a Special Session on Wednesday, May 24, 2023, Oviedo City Hall, 400 Alexandria Boulevard

PUBLIC COMMENT

Deputy Mayor Boddiford opened public comment. Hearing no one wishing to speak, public comment was closed.

ORDER OF BUSINESS

1. One Cent Sales Tax (Third Generation) Transportation Projects

City Manager Bryan Cobb provided background.

Public Works Director Bobby Wyatt provided a presentation.

Councilmember Teuchert asked about the impact on the storm water drainage system.

Assistant City Engineer Paul Yeargain stated that there is no impact on the storm water drainage system.

Mayor Sladek asked how to get students through the back Hagerty High School.

Councilmember Pollack clarified that the Development Agreement for Hagerty High School stated that students are not allowed to park in the back and are to come in off of Old Lockwood.

Council consensus was to move forward with the Mitchell Hammock Road Corridor Projects and the Lockwood Boulevard Corridor Project.

Recreation and Parks Paul Belden provided information on recreation projects that were completed using the Third Generation Sales Tax.

2. **Resolution No. 4438-23, Third Generation Sales Tax Adjustment**

City Manager Bryan Cobb provided background.

Deputy Mayor Boddiford opened public comment. Hearing no one wishing to speak, public comment was closed.

Mayor Sladek stated that there needs to be safeguard in place so this does not happen again.

Mr. Cobb confirmed that there are safeguards in place.

Finance Director Jerry Boop explained the safeguards in place.
