

RESOLUTION NO. 4064-21

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF OVIEDO, FLORIDA APPROVING A PIGGYBACK CONTRACT WITH COOLSYS, INC. AND ITS SUBSIDIARIES, FOR PROVIDING HVAC EQUIPMENT, INSTALLATION, REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE SERVICES, AND RELATED PRODUCTS; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE SAID PIGGYBACK CONTRACT; AND PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTING ADMINISTRATIVE ACTIONS, SCRIVENER'S ERRORS, CONFLICTS, SEVERABILITY, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Coolsys, Inc. and its Subsidiaries are providers of HVAC equipment, installation, repair/maintenance services, and related products; and

WHEREAS, The City performs annual preventative maintenance services on the City's refrigeration equipment and provides services to maintain the software and licensing for the City's building automation controls; and

WHEREAS, the National Cooperative Purchasing Alliance bid services and awarded a contract to Coolsys, Inc. and its Subsidiaries on August 24, 2020 under #02-87; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to piggyback the National Cooperative Purchasing Alliance contract in order that the contracted services may be readily available for use by the City of Oviedo when needed; and

WHEREAS, the Piggyback contract is provided in Exhibit 1.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OVIEDO, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Approval of Contract. The City Council approves the Piggyback contract with Coolsys, Inc. and its Subsidiaries provided in Exhibit 1.

SECTION 2. Authorizing the Mayor to Execute Contract. The City Council authorizes the Mayor to execute the Piggyback contract with Coolsys, Inc. and its Subsidiaries provided in Exhibit 1.

SECTION 3. Implementing Administrative Actions. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to take such actions as he may deem necessary and appropriate in order to implement the provisions of this Resolution. The City Manager may, as deemed appropriate, necessary and convenient, delegate the powers of implementation as herein set forth to such City employees as deemed effectual and prudent.

SECTION 4. Scrivener's Errors. Typographical errors and other matters of a similar nature that do not affect the intent of this Resolution, as determined by the City Clerk and City Attorney, may be corrected.

SECTION 5. Conflicts. All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict with any of the provisions of this Resolution are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6. Severability. If any Section or portion of a Section of this Resolution proves to be invalid, unlawful, or unconstitutional, it shall not be held to invalidate or impair the validity, force, or effect of any other Section or part of this Resolution.

SECTION 7. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
