

RESOLUTION NO. 4343-23

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF OVIEDO, FLORIDA, APPROVING A BUDGET AMENDMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$604,243 FOR REPAIRS AT RIVERSIDE PARK; AND PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTING ADMINISTRATIVE ACTIONS, SAVINGS, SCRIVENER'S ERRORS, CONFLICTS, SEVERABILITY, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Hurricane Ian made landfall in the state of Florida on Wednesday, September 28, 2022, and impacted the City of Oviedo on Thursday, September 29, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oviedo incurred substantial damage at Riverside Park as a result of Hurricane Ian; and

WHEREAS, funds are not included in the FY 2022-23 Amended Budget for the repair of damages caused by the impacts of Hurricane Ian; and

WHEREAS, to facilitate the necessary repairs at Riverside Park, and to ensure the timeliness of those repairs, Staff recommends approval of a budget amendment to recognize insurance proceeds and use of Fund Balance; and

WHEREAS, a budget amendment in the amount of \$604,243 is necessary to recognize the insurance proceeds received, and is provided as Exhibit 1.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OVIEDO, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Approval of a Budget Amendment. The City Council hereby approves the budget amendment provided in Exhibit 1.

SECTION 2. Implementing Administrative Actions. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to take such actions as may be deemed necessary and appropriate in order to implement the provisions of this Resolution. The City Manager may, as deemed appropriate, necessary and convenient, delegate the powers of implementation as herein set forth to such City employees as deemed effectual and prudent.

SECTION 3. Savings. All prior actions taken by, or on behalf of, the City of Oviedo relating to Hurricane Ian are hereby ratified and affirmed.

SECTION 4. Scrivener's Errors. Typographical errors and other matters of a similar nature that do not affect the intent of this Resolution, as determined by the City Clerk and City Attorney, may be corrected.

SECTION 5. Conflicts. All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict with any of the provisions of this Resolution are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6. Severability. If any Section or portion of a Section of this Resolution proves to be invalid, unlawful, or unconstitutional, it shall not be held to invalidate or impair the validity, force, or effect of any other Section or part of this Resolution.

SECTION 7. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
