

RESOLUTION NO. 4362-23

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF OVIEDO, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE SEMINOLE COUNTY SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE SAID MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTING ADMINISTRATIVE ACTIONS, SCRIVENER'S ERRORS, CONFLICTS, SEVERABILITY, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of the *City Charter of the City of Oviedo* the terms of office of the Mayor, Megan Sladek, incumbent; City Councilmember Group I seat, Natalie Teuchert, incumbent; expire December 4, 2023, and it is necessary to elect public officials to serve for the new two (2) year term beginning December 4, 2023; and

WHEREAS, at its July 17, 2023, meeting, the City Council adopted Ordinance Nos. 1734 and 1735 each calling for a referendum election of the registered electors residing within the corporate limits of the City of Oviedo to be held on November 7, 2023, to consider Renewal of the City's Economic Development Tax Exemption and issuance of General Obligation Bonds for the City's Public Safety Building Project; and

WHEREAS, since there is no County election on November 7, 2023, the Memorandum of Agreement provided in Exhibit 1 is necessary for the called City election on November 7, 2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OVIEDO, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Approval of Memorandum of Agreement. The City Council approves the Memorandum of Agreement provided in Exhibit 1.

SECTION 2. Authorization to Execute Memorandum of Agreement. The City Council authorizes the Mayor to execute the Memorandum of Agreement provided in Exhibit 1.

SECTION 3. Implementing Administrative Actions. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to take such actions as he may deem necessary and appropriate in order to implement the provisions of this Resolution. The City Manager may, as deemed appropriate, necessary and convenient, delegate the powers of implementation as herein set forth to such City employees as deemed effectual and prudent.

SECTION 4. Scrivener's Errors. Typographical errors and other matters of a similar nature that do not affect the intent of this Resolution, as determined by the City Clerk and City Attorney may be corrected.

SECTION 5. Conflicts. All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict with any of the provisions of this Resolution are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6. Severability. If any Section or portion of a Section of this Resolution proves to be invalid, unlawful, or unconstitutional, it shall not be held to invalidate or impair the validity, force, or effect of any other Section or part of this Resolution.

SECTION 7. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage by the City Council of the City of Oviedo, Florida.
