

## **RESOLUTION NO. 4365-23**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF OVIEDO, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING THE DEDICATED IMPROVEMENTS OF THE MOSKOWITZ DERMATOLOGY DEVELOPMENT AND AUTHORIZING THE COMMENCEMENT OF THE TWO (2) YEAR MAINTENANCE PERIOD; AND PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTING ADMINISTRATIVE ACTIONS, SCRIVENER'S ERRORS, CONFLICTS, SEVERABILITY, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the dedicated improvements for Moskowitz Dermatology development were reviewed by Public Works Inspectors during the construction process and found to be in compliance with the approved plans; and

**WHEREAS**, maintenance inspections will be conducted at six (6), twelve (12), eighteen (18) and twenty-two (22) months; and

**WHEREAS**, the developer will be notified in writing of any deficiencies found during the maintenance inspection and provided thirty (30) days to make needed corrections; and

**WHEREAS**, said maintenance period will expire on August 21, 2025.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OVIEDO, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1.** Acceptance of Dedicated Improvements. The City Council hereby accepts the dedicated improvements for Moskowitz Dermatology development and authorizes the commencement of the two (2) year maintenance period.

**SECTION 2.** Implementing Administrative Actions. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to take such actions as he may deem necessary and appropriate in order to implement the provisions of this Resolution. The City Manager may, as deemed appropriate, necessary and convenient, delegate the powers of implementation as herein set forth to such City employees as deemed effectual and prudent.

**SECTION 3.** Scrivener's Errors. Typographical errors and other matters of a similar nature that do not affect the intent of this Resolution, as determined by the City Clerk and City Attorney, may be corrected.

**SECTION 4.** Conflicts. All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict with any of the provisions of this Resolution are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 5.** Severability. If any Section or portion of a Section of this Resolution proves to be invalid, unlawful, or unconstitutional, it shall not be held to invalidate or impair the validity, force, or effect of any other Section or part of this Resolution.

**SECTION 6.** Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
