

RESOLUTION NO. 4366-23

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF OVIEDO, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE SUBMITTAL OF AN APPLICATION FOR A FLORIDA RECREATIONAL DEVELOPMENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (FRDAP) GRANT APPLICATION; APPROVING A WORK ORDER IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$4,000 WITH RMPK FUNDING FOR GRANT WRITING SERVICES IN CONNECTION WITH THE PREPARATION AND SUBMITTAL OF SAID GRANT APPLICATION; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE SAID WORK ORDER; PROVIDING FOR CITY COUNCIL APPROVAL OF GRANT AWARD; AND PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTING ADMINISTRATIVE ACTIONS, SCRIVENER'S ERRORS, CONFLICTS, SEVERABILITY, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Oviedo has an opportunity to apply for a Florida Recreational Development Assistance Program Grant for Riverwoods Park; and

WHEREAS, the grant totaling \$200,000 requires a local match of 100%, or \$200,000, for a total grant amount to \$400,000; and

WHEREAS, if approved, the funds will be utilized to renovate Riverside Park to include: multi-purpose field renovations, garbage receptacles, picnic tables, benches, new dog park, and parking lot improvements; and

WHEREAS, the associated grant improvements are consistent with the Recreation and Parks Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, if the City is awarded a grant, City Council approval will be required prior to accepting the awarded grant; and

WHEREAS, Work Order No. 23-413 has been prepared for the fixed fee amount of \$4,000 for grant writing services and provided in Exhibit 1; and

WHEREAS, the deadline for submission of said grant application is Thursday, August 31, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the City Attorney has opined that Recreation and Parks Impact Fees can be used in connection with the improvements at Riverside Park to fund the City's required local match of \$200,000.

WHEREAS, City Staff recommends that City Council approve the submittal of said application for a Florida Recreational Development Assistance Grant Program and approve the Work Order provided in Exhibit 1.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OVIEDO, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Authorization to Submit Grant Application. The City Council authorizes the

submittal of an application for a \$200,000 Florida Recreational Development Assistance Program Grant (FRDAP) to renovate Riverside Park to include: multi-purpose field renovations, garbage receptacles, picnic tables, benches, new dog park, and parking lot improvements.

SECTION 2. Authorization of Local Match. The City Council approves the required 100% local match of \$200,000 for a total grant program of \$400,000.

SECTION 3. Approval of Work Order for Grant Writing Services. The City Council approves the work order with RMPK Funding for an amount not to exceed \$4,000 for grant writing services provided in Exhibit 1.

SECTION 4. Authorization of City Manager to Execute Work Order. The City Council authorizes the City Manager to execute said Work Order provided in Exhibit 1.

SECTION 5. City Council Approval of Grant Award. If said grant application results in a grant award, City Council approval will be required prior to accepting said grant award.

SECTION 6. Implementing Actions. The City Manager is hereby delegated authority to implement the provisions of this Resolution in a plenary manner as deemed appropriate and advantageous to the City. The City Manager may, as deemed appropriate, necessary and convenient, delegate the powers of implementation as herein set forth to such City employees as deemed effectual and prudent.

SECTION 7. Scrivener's Errors. Typographical errors and other matters of a similar nature that do not affect the intent of this Resolution, as determined by the City Clerk and City Attorney, may be corrected.

SECTION 8. Conflicts. All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict with any of the provisions of this Resolution are hereby repealed.

SECTION 9. Severability. If any Section or portion of a Section of this Resolution proves to be invalid, unlawful, or unconstitutional, it shall not be held to invalidate or impair the validity, force, or effect of any other Section or part of this Resolution.

SECTION 10. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
