

RESOLUTION NO. 4028-21

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF OVIEDO, FLORIDA, APPROVING A SERVICE AGREEMENT FOR LIGHTING SERVICES WITH ORLANDO UTILITIES COMMISSION FOR STREET LIGHTING IMPROVEMENTS ALONG NORTH LOCKWOOD BOULEVARD IN THE AMOUNT OF \$486,121.59; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE SAID AGREEMENT; APPROVING A BUDGET AMENDMENT; AND PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTING ADMINISTRATIVE ACTIONS, SCRIVENER'S ERRORS, CONFLICTS, SEVERABILITY, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City's Streetlight Assessment Fund, which was established in 2018, provides for the payment of the City's streetlight utility payments, upgrades of streetlights to LED technology, and for the expansion of streetlight infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the Orlando Utilities Commission (OUC) and the City have an existing Interlocal Agreement (Agreement) for the provision of installation, maintenance, equipment and administration by OUC of lighting and chilled water systems, facilities and services which was executed on March 6, 2007; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement's existing term will expire on January 30, 2027, and automatically renew for four (4) successive five-year renewal periods; and

WHEREAS, existing street lighting along Oviedo Boulevard and Franklin Street was procured utilizing the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, to initiate the City's first streetlight assessment expansion project, staff solicited a proposal from OUC to add street lighting along North Lockwood Boulevard between County Road 419 and County Road 426, where no street lighting currently exists; and

WHEREAS, OUC staff prepared a design and installation Service Agreement for Lighting Service for the installation of lighting, poles, controllers, conduit and junction boxes in the amount of \$486,121.59; and

WHEREAS, funding currently exists in the FY 2020-21 Adopted Budget for capital improvements of \$165,000; and

WHEREAS, the Budget Amendment provided in Exhibit 2 is required to fund the remaining \$321,121.59 needed to implement the streetlight expansion project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OVIEDO, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Approval of Service Agreement. The City Council approves the Service Agreement for Lighting Service with the Orlando Utilities Commission in the amount of \$486,121.59 as provided in Exhibit 1.

SECTION 2. Authorizing the Mayor to Execute Agreements. The City Council authorizes the Mayor to execute the Service Agreement for Lighting Service as provided in Exhibit 1.

SECTION 3. Approval of Budget Amendment. The City Council hereby approves the Budget Amendment as provided in Exhibit 2.

SECTION 4. Implementing Administrative Actions. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to take such actions as he may deem necessary and appropriate in order to implement the provisions of this Resolution. The City Manager may, as deemed appropriate, necessary and convenient, delegate the powers of implementation as herein set forth to such City employees as deemed effectual and prudent.

SECTION 5. Scrivener's Errors. Typographical errors and other matters of a similar nature that do not affect the intent of this Resolution, as determined by the City Clerk and City Attorney, may be corrected.

SECTION 6. Conflicts. All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict with any of the provisions of this Resolution are hereby repealed.

SECTION 7. Severability. If any Section or portion of a Section of this Resolution proves to be invalid, unlawful, or unconstitutional, it shall not be held to invalidate or impair the validity, force, or effect of any other Section or part of this Resolution.

SECTION 8. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
