

## **RESOLUTION NO. 4034-21**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF OVIEDO, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF A FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH EMS MATCHING GRANT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE GRANT APPLICATION; AUTHORIZING THE 25% REQUIRED LOCAL MATCH; AND PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTING ADMINISTRATIVE ACTIONS, SCRIVENER'S ERRORS, CONFLICTS, SEVERABILITY, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the Florida Department of Health, has announced the FY 2021 EMS Matching Grant Program thereby providing a potential funding mechanism for the participants to secure grant revenue; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has no automated chest compression system and relies on manual compressions; and

**WHEREAS**, studies have shown that rescuer compressions degrade after only one minute; and

**WHEREAS**, the Fire Rescue Department has identified a need for three (3) LUCAS Chest Compression Systems to allow the City to provide patients the best available chance for survival, due to consistent depth and rates of compression while the patient is being treated and transported; and

**WHEREAS**, the purchase of three (3) LUCAS Chest Compression Systems are eligible for funding through the 2021 Florida Department of Health EMS Matching Grant Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the Fire Rescue Department recommends the submittal of a Florida Department of Health, EMS matching grant application for the procurement of three (3) LUCAS Chest Compression Systems for a potential grant award estimate of \$35,525.25 and a required 25% grant match of \$11,841.75.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OVIEDO, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1.** Approval of Grant Application Submission. The City Council approves the submission of a grant application for the 2021 Florida Department of Health EMS Matching Grant Program requesting funding assistance for three (3) LUCAS Chest Compression Systems.

**SECTION 2.** Authorization to Execute Application. The City Council authorizes the City Manager to execute said Grant Application to the Florida Department of Health EMS Matching Grant program.

**SECTION 3.** Authorization of Local Match. The City Council authorizes said grant application to include the required 25% local match.

**SECTION 4.** City Council Approval Required. If said grant application results in a grant award, City Council approval will be required prior to accepting said grant award.

**SECTION 5.** Implementing Administrative Actions. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to take such actions as he may deem necessary and appropriate in order to implement the provisions of this Resolution. The City Manager may, as deemed appropriate, necessary and convenient, delegate the powers of implementation as herein set forth to such City employees as deemed effectual and prudent.

**SECTION 6.** Scrivener's Errors. Typographical errors and other matters of a similar nature that do not affect the intent of this Resolution, as determined by the City Clerk and City Attorney, may be corrected.

**SECTION 7.** Conflicts. All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict with any of the provisions of this Resolution are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 8.** Severability. If any Section or portion of a Section of this Resolution proves to be invalid, unlawful, or unconstitutional, it shall not be held to invalidate or impair the validity, force, or effect of any other Section or part of this Resolution.

**SECTION 9.** Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
